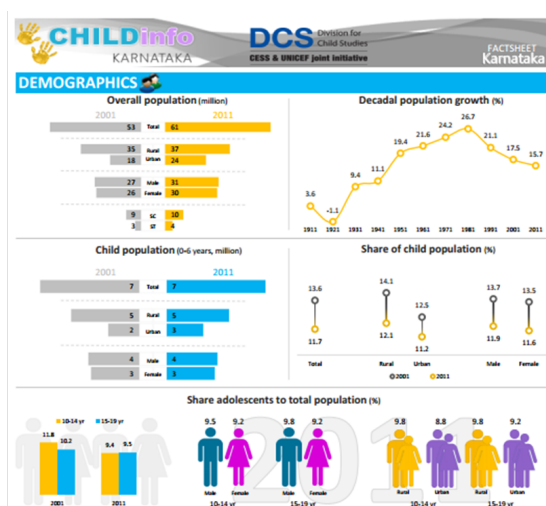
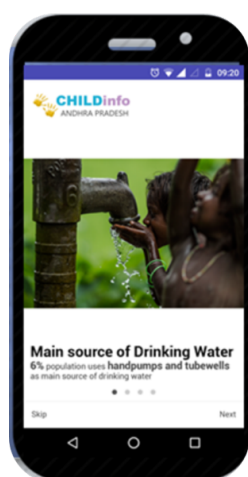


ChildInfo India

Monitoring the situation of children and women in three Indian states



In Andhra Pradesh, Karnataka and Telangana, the ChildInfo Portal brings together multiple tools to provide access to data in an intuitive manner: an online portal provides search access to data from different sources, and a dashboard, snapshots, mobile application and atlas support analytics for decision making.

The ChildInfo software provides up-to-date information on children, from approved government sources. Data from multiple sectors (economics, demographics, nutrition, health, child protection, drinking water, sanitation, HIV, education, and disability) is available at the district level, and regularly updated. The mobile application offers access to data on the go without an internet connection.

Features

- Web application for quick and easy data search at the state and district level
- Interactive online dashboard offers snapshot overview of states and districts
- State atlas tells a data story
- Online management tools for database managers
